W. JAY WORTLEY

DIRECTOR OF THE OFFICE OF REVENUE AND TAX ANALYSIS, STATE OF MICHIGAN

As Director of the Office of Revenue and Tax Analysis in the Michigan Department of Treasury, Jay's responsibilities include forecasting economic activity, estimating and tracking State Government revenues, estimating the potential fiscal impact of proposed tax legislation, and evaluating tax policy issues. Jay advises the State Treasurer on economic and revenue issues and is responsible for the Administration's economic and revenue forecasts.

Prior to joining the Treasury Department in September 2009, Jay was the Senior Economist for the Michigan Senate Fiscal Agency, a position he held for over 18 years. Prior to joining the Senate Fiscal Agency, Jay spent 1985 - 1990 in Washington, D.C., where he worked for the National Association of State Budget Officers and Price Waterhouse. Before going to Washington, D.C., in 1985, Jay spent 12 years as an economist with the Michigan Department of Management and Budget.

Jay received B.A. and M.A. degrees in Economics from Michigan State University.

John Rakolta, Jr. is chairman and chief executive officer of Walbridge, a privately held, top-50 construction company founded in Detroit in 1916. The company specializes in construction management, design-build, engineering management, general contracting, pre-construction, program management, and turnkey solutions, plus it self-performs services in concrete, equipment installation and facility management. Rakolta received a Bachelor of Science degree in Civil Engineering from Marquette University in 1970 and later completed the Smaller Company Management Program at Harvard Business School.

He joined Walbridge in 1971 as an estimator and held positions of increasing responsibility, culminating with his selection as chairman and CEO in 1993. As part of a re-branding program, the company became Walbridge in 2008.

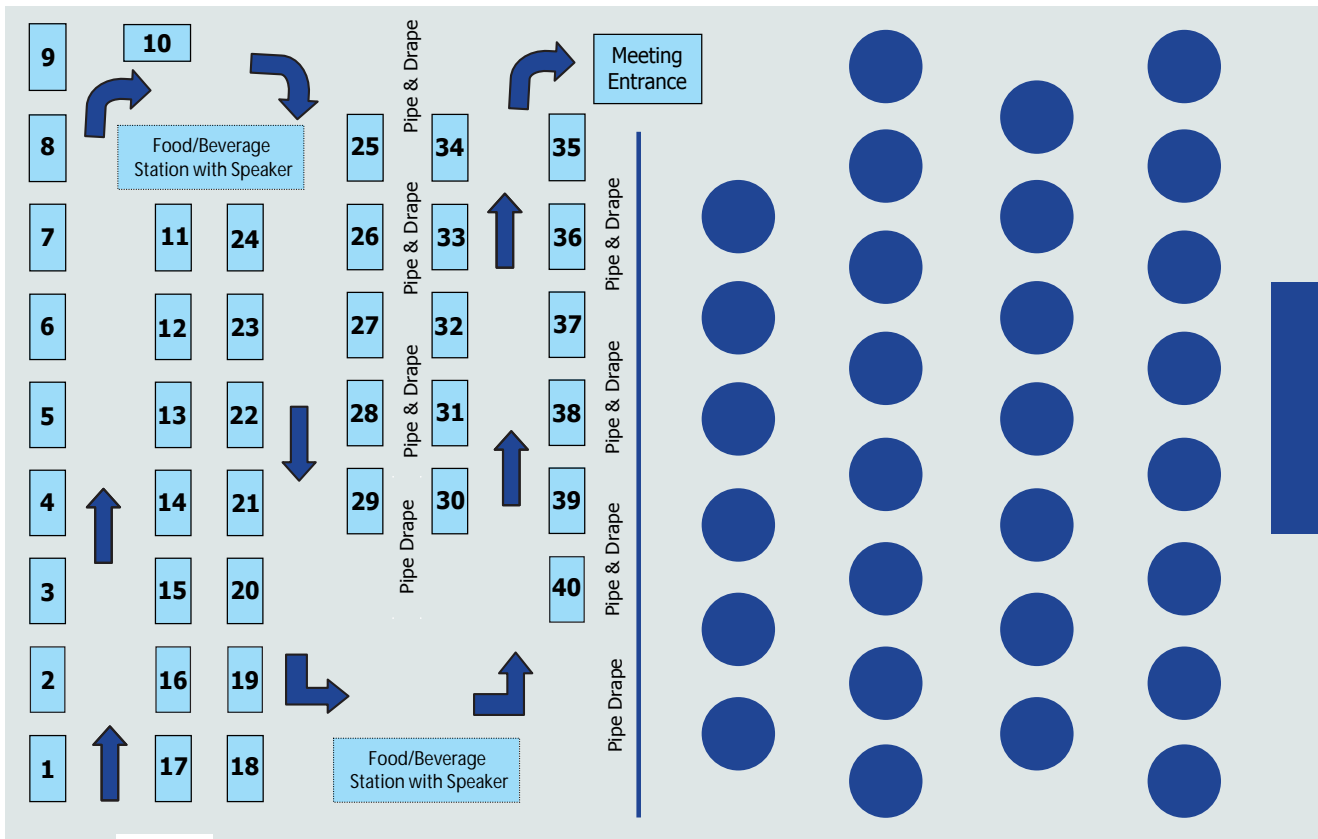
